  on the latest information available.
- If any child has been in close proximity with people who have been to any of these same countries recently, please also let us know by contacting info@supercamps.co.uk or calling 01235 467300 please also let us know so we may take this into consideration

We hope that you will understand the need for these increased measures. For information, please also note that we are not accepting any children on camp without these measures being communicated to the parents/guardian of that child. We appreciate our Easter Camp is a month away but we will implement further measures at short notice if deemed necessary by Public Health England and the NHS.
